

Activate StoryBook Creator Plus 3.0

StoryBook Creator 3.0 has two versions – the standard 3.0 version and Storybook Creator **Plus** 3.0. You have purchased the Plus version which offers many more features, including local printing and enhanced editing features.

1. When you first launch Storybook Creator 3.0, a box appears asking if you want to continue to run the free version of the software or upgrade to Plus 3.0.

Note: Your serial number is either on the back of your software packaging or in the confirmation e-mail you received when you purchased and downloaded the software.



2. Enter your serial number in the box provided.

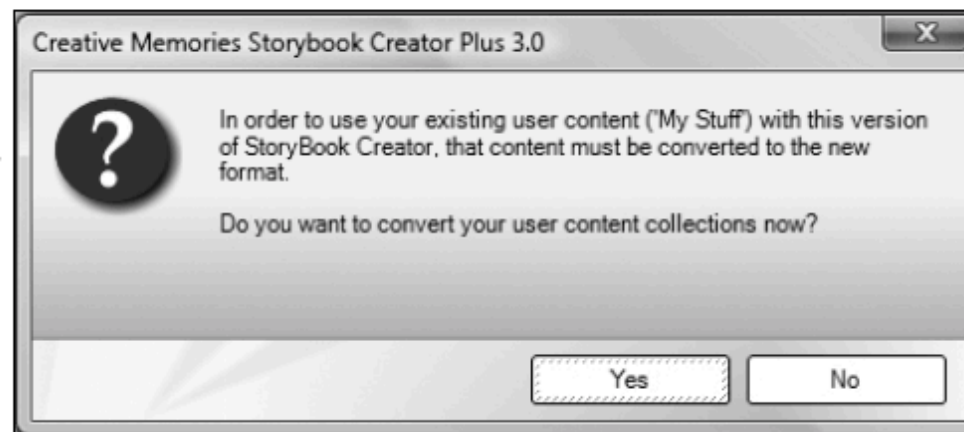
Note: You'll need to enter your serial number exactly as shown, in all capital letters and including all dashes.

3. The buttons will change after the serial number is entered. If you are upgrading from StoryBook Creator Plus to StoryBook Creator Plus 3.0, the software will automatically pull in your serial number from StoryBook Creator Plus. Be sure you're connected to the Internet and click **Activate now**.

Note: If online activation fails, you'll be given the option to activate over the telephone.

4. If you are upgrading from StoryBook Creator Plus to StoryBook Creator Plus 3.0, a dialog box will appear letting you know you'll need to convert the art you added under "My Stuff" to a new format before it can be used in version 3.0. If you agree, click **Yes**.

Note: Once upgraded for version 3.0, you will no longer be able to access this art content in the previous version of the software.



5. Another dialog box will appear asking you whether you want to move the content to a new location or keep it where it currently is saved. Make your choice and then click **Convert**.

6. A message will appear letting you know you need to restart the software for your changes to be accepted. Click **OK**.

7. The software will close. You need to relaunch the application from your desktop or the Windows Start menu.

Help System

Storybook Creator Plus 3.0 includes comprehensive documentation in the form of the Help system. To access **Help**, simply click the Help button in the ribbon bar (it will display as a question mark inside a circle). You may search the Help using keywords or the index, or you may click through topic by topic.

There are also Help buttons on dialog boxes and panels throughout the software. Click any button displaying a question mark to display Help topics specific to your location.

StoryBook Creator Plus 3.0 also includes a full user guide in Portable Document Format (PDF). you need Adobe Acrobat REader to view this user guide. If you do not have Acrobat Reader, you may download a free versions from <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readermain.html>
