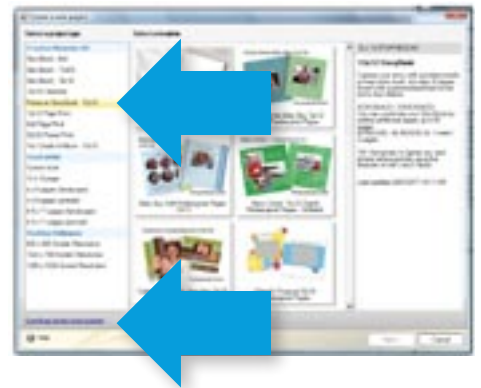
WHAT IS SO DIFFERENT ABOUT PREMIUM STORYBOOKS?

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

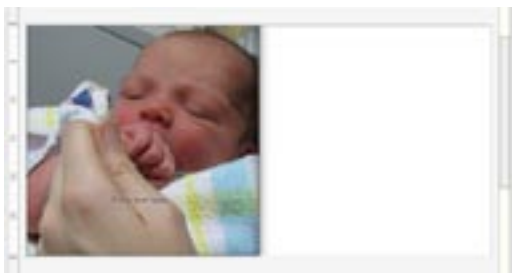
1. Firstly make sure you have done the most recent Software Update (Update 12). You should be prompted to do so by your software, otherwise visit the www.creativememories.com.au or www.creativememories.co.nz website, click on Product Info and then Software Updates.
2. Make sure you have updated your project types. In StoryBook Creator Software open the "Start a new project" window and click the blue "Check for new project types" link at the bottom left hand corner of the window.
3. Make sure you select 12 x 12 Premium StoryBook when creating your project.



CREATING A DOUBLE-PAGE PHOTO

Option 1 - Within StoryBook Creator 3.0 Software:

1. Change the View to Two Page.
2. Edit the left hand page of the double-page spread and add the photo you want to use to the page. Be sure the photo is high resolution so that when printed the photo isn't blurry or pixelated.
3. Resize the photo so that it is the size of both pages (you won't be able to see any image on the right hand page at this stage, but you will be able to see the image handles, the small white squares, are at the left and right sides of the double-page).



4. Select the photo and move it up or down inside the photo opening to get it into the position you want, before copying the photo.



5. Copy the photo and change editing the right hand page.
6. Paste the photo on the right hand page and then re-position the photo so that it matches up with the photo on the left hand page. You may need to zoom in where the two photos meet in the middle to be sure it is lined up.



Option 2 - Split the photo in Memory Manager 3.0 Software first:

1. In Memory Manager 3.0 Software, select the photo you want to use. Be sure the photo is high resolution so that when printed the photo isn't blurry or pixelated.
2. Re-size the image so that it measures 12.25 inches (318mm) by 24.25 inches (622mm). Then crop the photo into perfect halves saving both halves of the photo.
3. In your project in StoryBook Creator 3.0 Software, use a full page photo opening on both the left hand and right hand pages, and insert the two halves of your photo into each photo opening.
